

Your Guide to FAST Back to School Orientation 2022

WHO SHOULD COME TO ORIENTATION:

 <u>All FAST students</u> are expected to attend orientation with a parent. Attendance will be taken. If you have children that are not FAST students, please leave them home so we may limit the crowds. This is *officially* the first day of school. <u>Classes formally begin on</u> <u>Tuesday, August 9</u>.

WHEN IS ORIENTATION: August 8, 2022 at the times below.

1st Graders - 8th Graders

- If your child's last name begins with <u>A-K and is in grade 1-8.</u> you are expected to arrive between 9:00-11:00am.
- If your child's last name begins with <u>L-Z and is in grade 1-8</u>, you are expected to arrive between 12:30pm-2:30pm.

Kindergarteners

- If your child is in <u>Kindergarten and their last name begins with A-K</u>, their orientation will begin in their classroom at 9:30am. Please arrive with enough time to check in and navigate to the prospective classrooms.
- If your child is in <u>Kindergarten and their last name begins with L-Z</u>, their orientation will begin at 1:00 pm. Please arrive with enough time to check in and the prospective classrooms.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

Orientation is a time to get schedules, meet teachers, learn about enrichment activities and pick up PTO orders. This is a drop in event and teachers will be busy meeting all of their students. If you have questions or concerns that are specific to your student, please ask the teacher to schedule time to discuss rather than during orientation.

WHERE TO GO:

- First stop is the <u>Innovation Hall</u>:
 - Check in to pick up your student(s)' schedule
 - Stop by the PTO table for your pre-ordered spirit wear and membership incentives
 - Meet after school enrichment clubs
 - Get information about Yay Lunch!
 - Pick up forms to sign if you have not already completed the process
 - o Sign up for After School Programs and After School Care

• Second stop is the Student Hall:

- Pick up student schedule from the homeroom teacher (schedules are not final until Monday)
- Meet your teacher & complete any information required from them
- Drop off supplies
- Drop off medication and <u>medication forms</u>
- Turn in Family Agreement and Technology Agreement Forms

WHAT TO BRING:

- **TIME SAVER!!!** *Print* and *sign* the following documents in advance of orientation.
 - Parent/Student Handbook Agreement [Parent/Student Handbook]
 - o Device Contract
 - o <u>Technology Honor Agreement</u>
- Any medication that needs to be at the school and the appropriate forms to allow FAST Staff to administer it.
- School supplies that will remain in the classroom.

WHAT TO WEAR:

Uniforms are NOT required for orientation.
