



Your Guide to FAST Back to School Orientation 2024

WHO SHOULD COME TO ORIENTATION:

- All FAST students are expected to attend orientation. Attendance will be taken. If you have children that are not FAST students, please leave them home so we can limit crowds to the extent possible. This is officially the first day of school. **Classes formally begin on Tuesday, August 6.**

WHEN IS ORIENTATION: August 5, 2024 at the times below

- If your child's last name begins with A-K, you are expected to arrive between 9:00-11:00am.
- If your child's last name begins with L-Z, you are expected to arrive between 12:30pm-2:30pm.

WHERE TO GO:

- Parking on campus is limited, please be courteous to any staff directing traffic and adhere to fire lanes and other restricted parking areas.
- Your first stop when you arrive is **Innovation Hall**.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

Orientation is a time to get schedules, meet teachers, pick up carpool tags, learn about enrichment activities and pick up PTO orders. This is a drop in event and teachers will be busy meeting all of their students. *If you have questions or concerns that are specific to your student, please ask the teacher to schedule time to discuss rather than during orientation.*

- First stop is the Innovation Hall:
 - Check in to pick up your student(s)' schedule(s)
 - Pick up forms to sign if you have not already completed them
 - Meet after school enrichment clubs
 - Sign up for After School Programs and After School Care

- Second stop is the Student Hall:
 - Meet your teacher & complete any information required from them
 - Drop off supplies
 - Pick up pre-ordered spirit wear
 - Drop off medication and medication forms
 - Turn in Family Agreement and Technology Agreement Forms

WHAT TO BRING:

- Any outstanding documents including those required for enrollment, updated [immunization forms for 7th graders](#), and [residency verification](#) documents for 6th graders if you have not already provided them.
 - TIME SAVER: email documents directly to alexandra.hernandez@fastk8.org prior to orientation.
- Any medication that needs to be at school and the appropriate forms to allow FAST Staff to administer it which can be found on the [FCS website](#).
- School supplies that will remain in the classroom.
